Thursday: What makes it hard to honor others above ourselves? Today let's ask God to search our hearts to show us the ways we seek honor for ourselves, instead of honoring others.

Friday: We know our focus should be on the Lord, but it is so easy to get distracted in all sorts of ways. Let's pray today and every day that through the Holy Spirit, God would maintain our zeal and spiritual fervor to seek and serve him.

Saturday: Let's take time today to prepare our hearts and schedules to gather for worship tomorrow. What do we need to do today to be wholeheartedly ready to focus on Jesus and love and honor one another tomorrow?
